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Why? Constructive alignment

(Biggs, 1996)

ILOs: knowledge, academic skills and practical skills





Support all student profiles including those with practical skills-based careers and support different learning styles.



Traditional assessments (e.g. essays) do not scale well

Authentic assessments: Aligns practice, theory and real world application (Villaroel et al., 2018) with benefits for student engagement, retention and performance
